

Membership fee for the Advanced UV for Life e. V.

Association for the Promotion of UV Semiconductor Technologies

- (1) The membership fee of institutional members for the current year shall be determined according to the total turnover from the annual financial statement of the previous year. The membership fees are as follows:

between 0,5 and 1 million	550,00
between 1 and 2 million	810,00
between 2 and 5 million	1.620,00
between 5 and 10 million.	2.700,00

students, retired persons	60,00

- (2) For institutions which are predominantly publicly funded (recipients of subsidies), the sum of the personnel and material subsidies shall apply for the assessment of the contribution.
- (3) The membership fee of companies and institutions which are not predominantly active in fields in line with the purpose of the Association shall be determined from the turnover of the legally dependent sub-organisation working in the field of UV technologies and has not acquired an own membership. Likewise, the fees of a member within the meaning of Article 4 (2) of the statutes shall be determined on the basis of the values attributable to that member in accordance with paragraph (1) or (2). In the aforementioned cases, the approval of the Executive Board is required.
- (4) At the end of the current year, the Executive Board shall determine the amount of the subscription for the following year by means of a written questionnaire to the member.
- (5) The annual subscription may be paid in up to 2 annual instalments. The individual instalments shall be due at the end of the first calendar month of the first and third quarters.
- (6) Members who are only admitted in the course of a current year shall only pay fees in proportion to the full calendar months during which they were members.
- (7) The Executed Board is authorised to issue regulations for the termination of membership in the case that due subscription payments are not made despite several reminders.
- (8) Changes in membership fees in one of the above defined turnover classes may not be decided against a majority of 2/3 of the members of the membership fee class concerned.

*) A start-up company is a recently founded company with its own innovative business idea and high growth potential without a connection to a larger established company or group of companies.

***) Personal memberships of members of companies active in the UV sector, instead of the company's membership, are generally not provided for.
